

**SOO TOWNSHIP MONTHLY BOARD MEETING
CONDUCTED VIA ZOOM
January 13, 2021**

The January Board Meeting was conducted by zoom as a result of the Covid pandemic and Governor's orders. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor, Larry Perron. Pam Chipman, Jeff Killips and Chuck Palmer were in attendance by Zoom.
