

**SOO TOWNSHIP MONTHLY BOARD MEETING**

The September meeting was called to order at 7 p.m. by Supervisor, Larry Perron. The Pledge of Allegiance followed. Jeff Killips and Chuck Palmer were in attendance.

**A motion was made by Don Kucharczyk and supported by Cheryl Thoresen to approve the minutes of the August 13, 2014 board meeting. Motion carried.**

Jeff Killips reported that the annual Fire Department Open House and Barbecue will be Saturday, September 20<sup>th</sup> from 2:00-5:00 pm.

The Budget vs Actual for August was presented. **A Motion was made by Cheryl Thoresen and supported by Don Kucharczyk to make the following line items changes:**

**Transfer \$500 from Treasure/Data Processing to Treasurer/Legal-Reimburse. Transfer \$2000 from Fire Dept/Op. Supplies to Fire Dept/Equip-Maintenance. A Roll-call vote was taken: Larry Perron-yes, Don Kucharczyk-yes, Andree Watson-yes, and Cheryl Thoresen-yes. Jim Callon was absent. Motion carried.**

**A Motion was made by Cheryl Thoresen and supported by Andree Watson to approve the following Precinct Workers for the November 4, 2014 election: Rose Talentino, Chairperson, Gail Essmaker, Harold Essmaker, Bev Harwood, Gloria Larke, Barb Mapes, Betty Suriano, Andree Watson, and Bev Youngs. Motion Carried.**

Treasurer, Cheryl Thoresen reported that the last day to pay summer taxes without penalty is Monday, September 15<sup>th</sup>. The office will be open from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Ten Soo Township residents have utilized the new credit card system for paying taxes.

Attorney, Chuck Palmer reported that a show cause hearing is scheduled for October 1<sup>st</sup> on the Pezzolesi property.

Supervisor, Larry Perron reported that complaints have been received on the following property locations:

- 4418 S. Seymour Road
- 494 W 6 Mile Road
- Barn on Bradley property

Attorney to follow up with letters of violations.

**A Motion was made by Don Kucharczyk and supported by Cheryl Thoresen to amend the Motion of August 13<sup>th</sup> to pave 15 Mile Road, a distance of 1.36 Miles and Cummings Road and 17 1/2 Mile Road, a distance of 1.5 Miles at a cost not to exceed \$220,000, to not to exceed \$230,000, if necessary. A Roll-call vote was taken: Don Kucharczyk-yes, Andree Watson-yes, Cheryl Thoresen-yes and Larry Perron-yes. Jim Callon was absent. Motion carried.**

Supervisor, Larry Perron, reported that the water hook-up project to Tribal Housing on Seymour Road is going well. Progress is being made at 400 to 500 feet per day and residents wanting to hook-up should call Pat Hebert at 248-0215.

**A motion was made by Don Kucharczyk and supported by Andree Watson to pay the August bills from ck #7299 to ck #7305 totaling \$3,249.40, including Electronic Transfer in the amount of \$499.57 for Federal/State Posters and September bills from ck #7306 to ck #7345 totaling \$19,196.23 including Electronic Transfer in the amount of \$3,667.72 for September payroll taxes. Motion carried.**
